Location & Travel Directions:

Registration, start and finish will take place in the old village school in Ineia. There is sufficient parking on the North side and in the school grounds (use the road on North side). Directions are: From Paphos take the B7 and turn left onto the E711 after Stroumbi. Turn left for Ineia at Pano Arodhes. Drive through both Pano and Kato Arodes to Ineia. In Ineia take first right up to the big church of Panagias Chyseleousa, turn right, then turn left and take second right signposted to event. Alternatively, from Peyia take the E709 uphill till it joins the E711 after Kathikas and then as above. Timings:

Registration will be available from 1015 hrs and the course will be open from 1030 hrs. Last start will be at 1130 hrs and the course will close at 1300 hrs. No starts will be available after 1130 hrs.

Courses:

Three courses will be available:
Championship "A Course" (for KOA card holders only) - A technical course of approximately 5.6 kms
Introductory "B Course" - A less technical course of approximately 4.2 kms.
Introductory "C Course" - A simpler beginner's course of approximately 2.3 km.

Terrain:

An sloping urban and rural area, with a maze of twisting streets in some parts, mostly tarmac roads and some loose surface tracks. Fast running with good visibility. There will be normal Sunday traffic (pedestrians, cyclists, cars) around both villages. Thus, runners are cautioned to take care.

Map:

 On the A and B Courses there will be the additional challenge of a map flip section with a larger scale involved. Maps will be pre-marked. Loose control descriptions will be available.



Equipment:

Runners are to provide their own compass and **whistle**. **A whistle check will be made before the start for your own safety!** Whistles are available at registration for €2. Full leg coverage is not mandatory but recommended. Sport-ident electronic timing will be used. Own Sport-ident cards may be used. Hire of Sport-ident card is charged at €2 but loss of hired Sport-ident card will be charged at €40 each.

Facilities:

There are toilets available in the Ineia School building. Refreshments are encouraged to be purchased from nearby restaurants/cafes/shops in Ineia. Please support the village community.

Registration:

Entry Fee:

An entry fee of €4.00 per person will be charged for local club members (not including SI card hire which is **€2.00**) payable on the day at registration. Children under twelve are half price. Children under five are FREE! For non local Club members the entry fee is €6 per person (not including SI card hire which is **€2.00**). **NB – ALL LATE ENTRIES AFTER 24TH OCTOBER WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE ENTRY FEES!**

League Event:
